Albers, E.G., Texas Ranger 1923 – 2011

Capt. Albers was born August 10, 1923, in Lee County near Giddings. He entered military service in 1942.

In 1946, he began his law enforcement career with Pampa Police Department. He entered the Department of Public Safety in 1949 as a Highway Patrolman stationed at Amarillo, Houston and Pampa.

Capt. Albers was appointed in 1961 as a Texas Ranger stationed at Canyon, promoted to Sergeant in 1968 at Midland, and promoted in 1969 to Captain of Ranger Company F in Waco.

He attended D.P.S. Law Enforcement Academy and later was instructor for several recruit schools at D.P.S. Academy. He was the first Texas Ranger to graduate from the F.B.I. National Academy (84th Session) and received his BS degree from the University of Central Texas in Criminal Justice.
