Lloyd Johnson, Texas Ranger, Retired 1929 - 2014

Texas Ranger Lloyd Johnson, age 85, of Sulphur Springs was born on February 14, 1929 in Mt. Vernon, TX, the son of Weaver Henry and Lillis Virginia (Reeves) Johnson. He married Jo Ann Staples on December 16, 1955 in Tyler, TX.

Mr. Johnson attended Winona Schools and graduated from Tyler High School in 1945. Mr. Johnson served in the Navy during the Korean War and served on board the USS Wasp. He worked for the

Department of Public Safety, including service as a Texas Ranger from 1974 to 1993, and retired after 35 years.

He was a 50 year member of the Castilian Masonic Lodge #141 and was a Past Master. Mr. Johnson was a member of First United Methodist Church. In addition to his wife Jo Ann, he is survived by three sons.
