Ranger B. J. Green was born to Charles and Leona Green in Archer County Dec. 14, 1930. He was a star high school athlete, a proud member of the United States Marine Corps, a longtime Mason, a devoted husband, and loving father.

B.J. began his 38-year career in law enforcement as a Texas Highway Patrolman before serving in Companies "C" and "D" of the Texas Rangers. He retired as a lieutenant in the Criminal Investigations Division of the Lubbock County Sheriff's Department.
