A Message from Chief Chance Collins on the Passing of Captain Jack Dean

It is with a heavy heart that I announce the passing of Retired Texas Ranger Captain Jack Dean; father of Retired Texas Ranger Kyle Dean (Kerrville) and Texas State Trooper Cody Dean (Floresville).

Jack was born on June 16, 1937 in Green Valley, Texas. He married Janie Lee Hill on December 20, 1955 and joined the Texas Department of Public Safety in 1960.



Captain Dean served as a Texas Highway Patrolman in Pecos and Tyler before promoting to Texas Ranger in 1970. Captain Dean was stationed in McAllen, Waco and San Antonio throughout his Ranger service, retiring in 1993 after serving 15 years as the Captain of Company "D".

From 1994 to 2004 Jack served as the United States Marshal for the Western District of Texas - San Antonio. He was an original founding member of the Texas Ranger Association Foundation (TRAF) and a current board member of TRAF - HQ Company.
