McAllen – Frank G. Horger died June 20, 1999, at McAllen Medical Center. Frank was born Feb. 14, 1927.

He attended McAllen schools and was All-State center for the McAllen High School Bulldogs. He served in the U.S. Marine Corp during World War II. He began his law enforcement career with the McAllen Police Department.

He then was a highway patrolman with the Texas Department of Public Safety for 11 years and was a Texas Ranger for 25 years. After 38 years in law enforcement, he retired in 1986.

In 1951, Frank married Frances Means. They had two sons and one daughter. He was preceded in death by his father, Henry David Horger, in 1968; and his mother, Olive Horger, in 1998.

Survivors are his wife, Frances; sons, Lane Horger (Rose) of Austin and David Linn Horger (Anita) of Round Top, Texas; daughter, Linda Horger Clark of South Padre Island and McAllen; sister, Marilyn Bormann (N.L.) of McAllen; brother, David Horger Jr. of Arlington; seven grandchildren, two great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
