



James A. Scoggins Feb 1, 1963 – Mar 10, 2023

Born on February 1, 1963 in Farmers Branch, Texas. Scoggins passed away on March 10, 2023, at the age of 60, in Waco, Texas. He led the Unsolved Crimes (UCIP) Program Supervisor, Texas Ranger Division – Waco.

James began his career with DPS on October 4, 2004. He was promoted from THP Fredericksburg to the Ranger Division on

September 1, 2009, and was stationed in San Antonio. On April 1, 2012, he was promoted to Lieutenant, Co. "F" Waco. On February 26, 2013, James was involved in a motorcycle accident in the Chisos Mountains in the Big Bend National Park area and was seriously injured. James persevered thru his injuries and essentially returned to work on February 2, 2015, in a non-commissioned position, overseeing the Unsolved Crimes Investigative Program and the six UCIP Rangers.

A funeral service will be held on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at 1:00 PM at the Waco Memorial Funeral Home, Cemetery & Cremations at 6623 Interstate 35 S, Robinson, Texas 76706. Following the service, and on the same property, James will be put to rest in a mausoleum burial.

Immediately following the mausoleum burial, everyone is invited to attend a gathering to celebrate James' life at Knox Hall, located at 100 Texas Ranger Trail, Waco, Texas 76706, where a catered meal will be provided.
