Candles, Open Flame or Fireworks	Please do not use: Candles, kerosene lanterns, fryers, grills and Sterno warmers, fireworks or pyrotechnics. These can start a fire. Battery powered candles and lanterns are allowed. Licensed caterers may use attended buffet warmers.
Sliding Across Floor	Please use wheeled push carts or dollies to move decorations, band equipment, chairs and tables. Dragging equipment, decorations or tables and chairs scars the floor. Motorized carts or lifts are not permitted because the floor is not designed to support them.
Hay Bales, Dirt or Sand	Please NO hay bales, dirt and sand. They contain insects that will infest the museum and guests! Flowers, artificial and potted plants are welcome!
	Please NO rice, confetti, streamers, silly string or candy (from party poppers or piñatas) inside or outside the facility. They take extra time to clean up and will incur clean up charges.

Smoke or Fog Machines	Smoke machines WILL set off our fire alarms and the Waco Fire Department may stop your party. They also create problems for guests with asthma or breathing difficulties.
Margarita Machines and Beer Kegs	Margarita Machines and Beer Kegs are NOT
	permitted. They leave sticky residue on the floor and are often left behind for others to pick up or return. Avoid extra clean-up charges and storage fees. City ordinances prohibit self-serve alcoholic beverage. Alcohol must be served by a licensed alcoholic beverage server.
